Basically i just want to create a general Out link 35% to galleries and 65% to trade. I've already put 65% skim in my general setting.

in your `"* * * * * cd/usr/local/apache/sites/client926/nylonfreeporn.com/htdocs/ftt/secure/; cron.php >/dev/null;"` main errors is no space between `cd` and `/usr/local/` and `php` was not called

Right line:

`*/* * * * * cd /usr/local/apache/sites/client926/nylonfreeporn.com/htdocs/ftt/secure/; /usr/bin/php cron.php >/dev/null;`
`/usr/bin/php` may be need to be replaced with `/usr/local/bin/php`. Depends on your system.

Type in shell:

`whereis php`

to find exact location of `php` executable.
